 - a. Plumbing/Pipefitting background
 - i. Licensed Journeyman
 - ii. Experienced in commercial plumbing preferred
 - iii. Commercial Pipefitting
 - iv. Steam and Hydronics
 - b. Instructor experience
 - i. Should have experience teaching within trade setting
 - ii. UA ITP experience preferred
2. Job Description
 - a. Will be required to prepare for the day to day operation of the classes
 - b. Will be teaching 1st year curriculum for service and building trades
 - c. 3rd & 4th year building trades fundamental courses
 - d. All plumbing courses including plumbing exam prep
 - e. Will be teaching steam, hydronics and pipefitting fundamentals
 - f. Willingness to acquire master plumber license within one year
